Hi Friends —

Impeccably dressed in the inevitable tuxedo, more often seated at the piano than posed at the mic, **Buddy Greco** is in equal parts charming and cocky. But that cockiness is the key to his charm. Other singers may plead, "Love me." Buddy proclaims, "Dig me. (Or don't. Your loss.)" Some performers have tried to copy his act, but none could copy his cool. Why? Because Buddy's cool is no act.

Yeah, he's as hip as his *paisan*, Ol' Blue Eyes, but it's his own special brand of devil-may-care hipness. Who else would be so audacious as to release an album with an inside-joke title tweaking Sinatra's classic *Songs for Swingin' Lovers* — Buddy's *Songs for Swingin' Losers*? And man, does he swing!

Then there are those brash and, frankly, wacky new lyrics that Buddy inserted into his version — the *hit* version — of [\[click here\]](#) "**The Lady Is a Tramp**": "*She's not so hot, but her shape is her own*" and "*I crave affection, baby, but not when I drive*" and so on. That's why our Buddy is a champ.

And Buddy's musicianship is indisputable. Benny Goodman recognized that in 1949 when he hired the twenty-three year old kid as his pianist *and* arranger. Think about it: how many top popular singers could have made a (far less lucrative, admittedly) living as a jazz instrumentalist? It's a very short list. Nat King Cole, of course. Ray Charles, obviously. And Buddy Greco. And not even Nat Cole walked the line between jazz and pop more deftly than my **August Just Jazz Artist of the Month, Buddy Greco**.

[Roni Ben-Hur & Santi Debriano: *Our Thing* \(Motéma\)](#): Previous collaborations with guitarist Gene Bertoncini and bassist Nilson Matta have shown guitarist Roni Ben-Hur to be a resourceful and sensitive musical partner. On this new outing he is joined by another gifted colleague, bassist Santi Debriano, for a delightful program of largely Brazilian-infused jazz. The brilliant drummer Duduka Da Fonseca rounds out the stellar trio.

[Duduka Da Fonseca: *Samba Jazz — Jazz Samba* \(Anzic\)](#): No matter which way you say it, "Samba Jazz" or "Jazz Samba," no one does it better than drummer Duduka Da Fonseca. Whether playing the music of Ornette Coleman and Jimmy Rowles or Dom Salvador and Toninho Horta, Da Fonseca, saxophonist-clarinetist Anat Cohen, pianist Helio Alves, guitarist Guilherme Monteiro, and bassist Leonardo Cioglia erase all labels but one: "great music."

[Roberta Piket: *Solo* \(Thirteenth Note\)](#): The best musicians like challenges, need challenges, look for challenges, and so, pianist Roberta Piket has taken on the special challenge of a full-length solo album. At times impressionistic, at other times intense, her treatments of songs by Monk, Strayhorn, Shorter, Corea, and more — including a charming piece composed by her father, Frederick Piket — reveal another dimension of her already formidable artistry.

[Andrew Swift: *Sift Kick* \(D Clef\)](#): This strong debut release by drummer Andrew Swift — Australian native, NYC resident — offers a broad and engaging range of colors and moods. Swift's versatility is enhanced by a talented cast of players, including trumpeter Ryan Kisor, trombonists Michael Dease and Wycliffe Gordon, saxophonists Eric Alexander and Sharel Cassity, pianist George Cables, and guitarist Yotam, plus two vocals by Vanessa Perea.

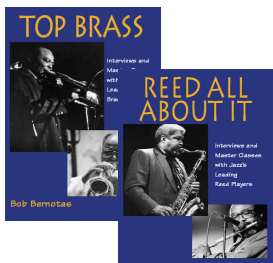
