Since then it has donated hundreds of instruments to Africa, has initiated music projects for children in orphanages, and has been supporting a refuge for vulnerable girls from the slums. This opportunity to learn and play music has been life changing for these disadvantaged children, bringing them self-confidence, pride, and joy.

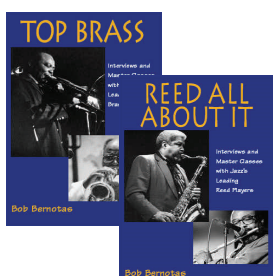
